
Manually Setting Business Outcomes

Stages and Levels


The Map displays Agile Outcomes grouped in horizontal rows by level, and in vertical columns by state. For more details about stages and levels, see P2A Overview.

For organizations that have multiple systems and multiple teams created, the map will display a down arrow indicator for the row:



Click on the down arrow to expand that level to show details for individual systems/teams:





The right side panel provides access to a number of details and functions including:

- Path to Agility Hierarchy (Stage, Level, etc)
- Description
- Progress Rating (Can be updated directly from the side panel)
