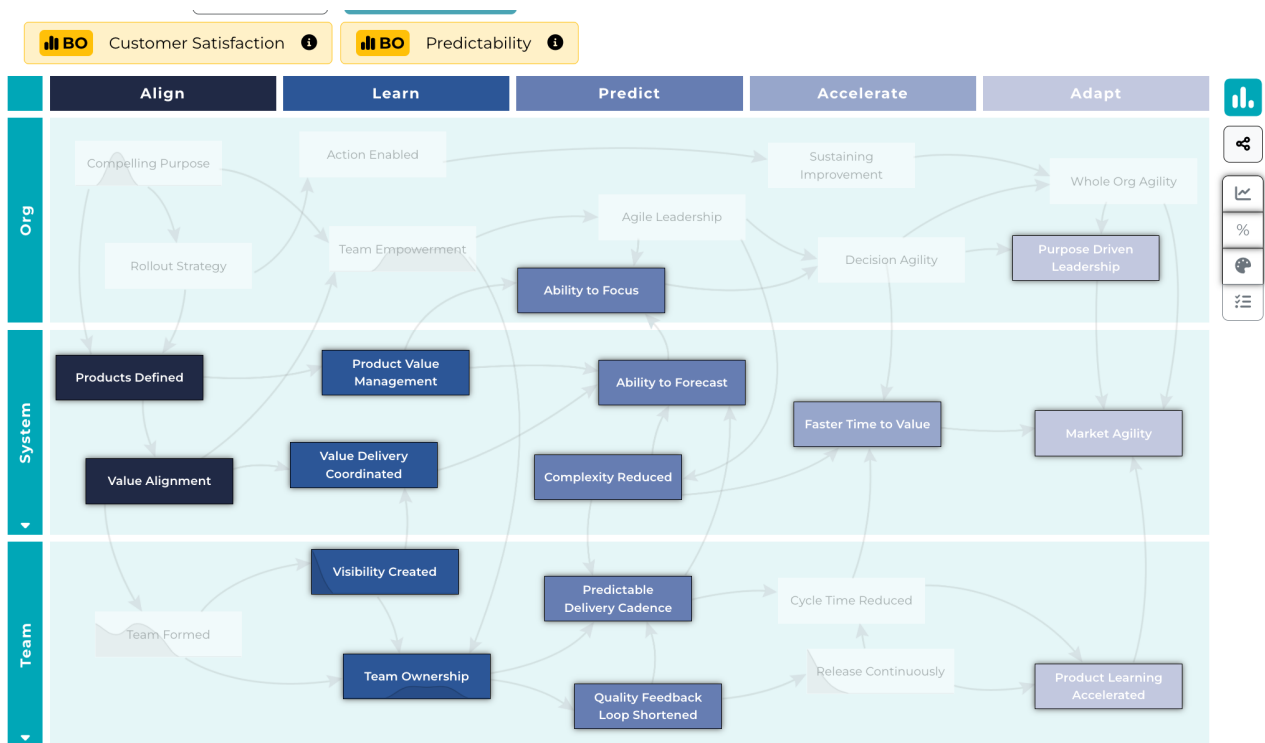
1. Click the  button to manually set the Business Outcomes for your Organization

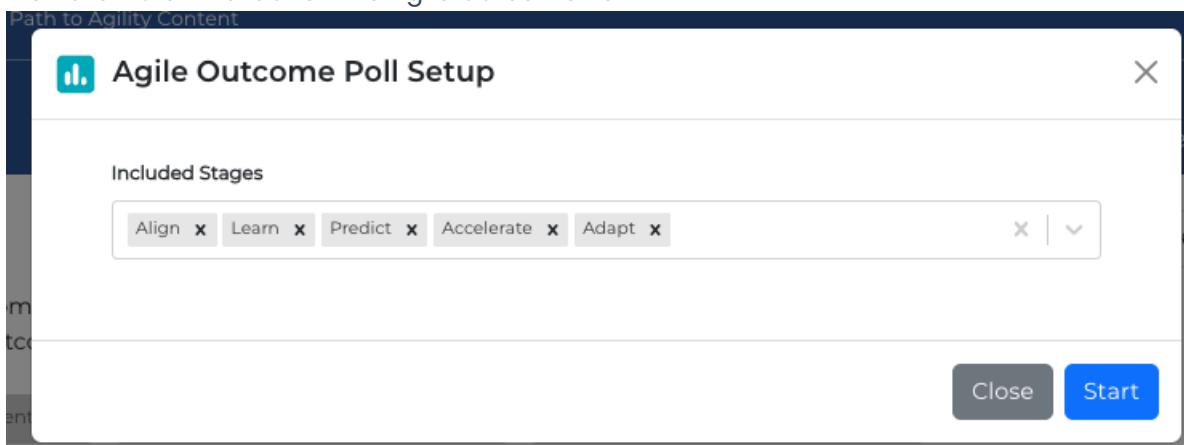
## Highlighting Connections Between Business Outcomes and Agile Outcomes

If just beginning with Path to Agility and establishing a baseline, consider removing Accelerate and Adapt stages.

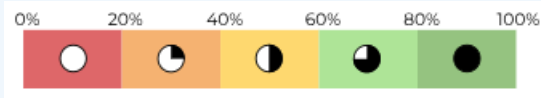
## Controlling Map Display Details

## Stages and Levels

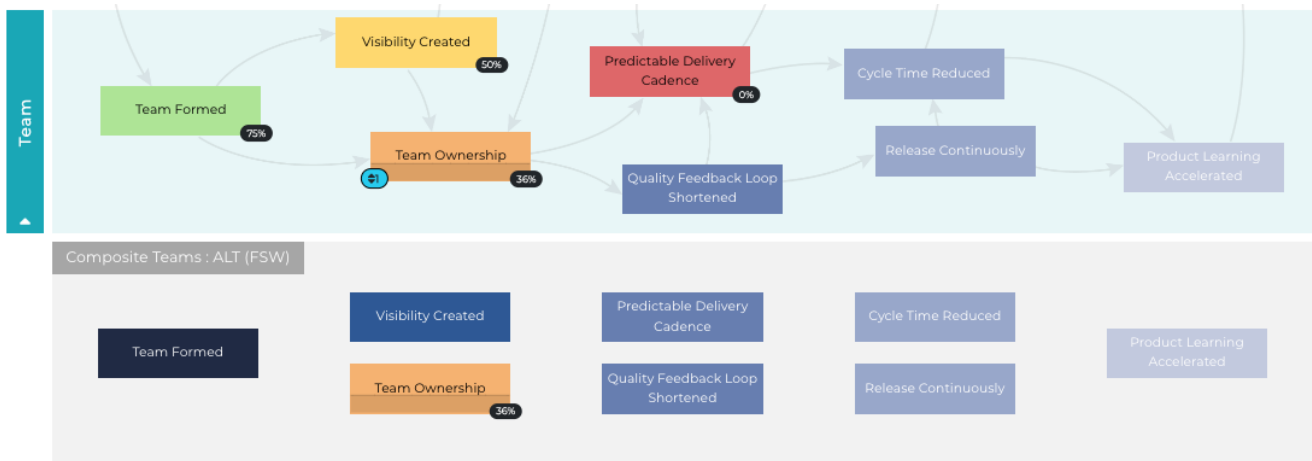
The Map displays Agile Outcomes grouped in horizontal rows by level, and in vertical columns by state. For more details about stages and levels, see [P2A Overview](#).
