### **Overview**

With Assessments, you can gather data at the Agile Capability level for eachteam, system, and organization. The Assessment view allows authorized users of P2ANav to create new and manage existing assessments.

### **Key User Interface Elements**




Access to the Assessment view user interface elements is managed by individual P2ANav user permissions. Your screen may vary from the details displayed below.

### **Assessments View**

#### **No Assessments in Progress**


1. If there are no assessments in progress, you'll be able to use the "New Assessment" button in the upper right corner of the screen.



- 2. Click "New Assessment" to create an assessment for all levels of the company organization, system, and team
- 3. Fill out the new assessment creation form:



- o Name: A short descriptive name
- o Date: Click to access a data selector
- Create
- 4. You will then be guided to the Assessment Dashboard.




### **Assessment in Progress**

Only one assessment can be in progress at a time.

A single assessment includes all levels of the company: Organization, System(s), and Team(s)


Users with appropriate permissions can manage details of an assessment in progress:



- Name and Date: Click on "Edit Name/Date"
- **Delete Assessment**: All data for all levels in the company for this assessment will be deleted. This cannot be undone.
- **Publish Assessment:** This assessment will be published for all levels: organization, System(s), and Team(s). The results will be published to the Map and Capabilities views, and will be used to update P2A index calculations on the Prioritization view.

# **Managing and Launching Assessments**

Users can navigate to view polls by clicking the tab view that they want to see (ie Organization or Teams).




Each level has Interface elements that impact only that level. These elements are described below.

#### **Launch an Assessment**



If an assessment **has not been started,** clicking the "New" button next to a level opens the Agile Capability Assessment Setup Option for that layer

- Included Stages: Chose from Path to Agility stages
- Assessment Options
  - o Live Poll See Facilitating a Live Poll
  - Async Poll See Facilitating an Async Poll
- **Assign host**: Available for Live Polls only. Optional. Enter the email address of another P2ANav user who will host the assessment. These users will be able to Pause and Re-start the poll.
- **Start**: Starts the assessment for that level. For details see Facilitating a Live Agile Capability Assessment Poll





If the assessment for a level **has been started**, the button text will read **Continue**, and clicking the Continue button brings the host to the assessment facilitation view.

### **Assessment Completion**

During an assessment facilitation session, the host can mark that level's assessment as complete.

Assessment completion status can also be changed from the assessment view screen (provided at least one capability has been scored) using the "Mark Complete" button:



#### **View Data**

Clicking on "Go to Capabilities" will open the corresponding Capability Heatmap

### **Publishing Assessment**

When your organization has finished assessing all of the capabilities you want to assess at each level, click "Publish" to mark the organization's assessment complete.
